Description of Activities	<p>In 2021 WIRI ran ten online webinars via the Zoom platform (all online due to the Covid-19 pandemic). Three webinars near Women's Day (8th March 2021) were run in collaboration with other societies. The titles of the ten webinars were as follows: 1) Tracademia: The experiences of trans people in academia: the joy and the pain; 2) Inclusive Leadership in Academia; 3) A New Vision for Trinity: Q & A with Provost Candidates; 4) COVID19 – Ensuring Women's Voices are Heard in Media; 5) Irish Scientists and the COVID Response; 6) Mental Health Workshop Series 1: Dealing with Toxicity in the Workplace; 7) Addressing the Issue of Race in an Irish Context: Moving Beyond the use of American Terminologies; 8) Mental Health Workshop Series 2: Motivation Mojo 101: Missing that Thrill; 9) The Legacy of Direct Provision; and 10) Gender and the Casualisation of Work in Irish Universities.</p>

Events lasted approximately 1 hour each with 45 minute discussion followed by 10 - 15 minutes Q&A from the audience. WIRI encourages solution based conversations raising awareness and leaving attendees with tools to help in future academic and research endeavors.
